PROCEDURE MEMO 15-01 – Surviving Spouse on Louisiana Death Records

As a result of the United States Supreme Court ruling in the case of *Obergefell v. Hodges*, any decedent who is legally married in Louisiana or in another state should have the death record reflect the surviving spouse, including a spouse of the same sex. This would include individuals that were legally married in other states prior to the issuance of this decision. The surviving spouse must be listed on the "Personal" tab in the "Surviving Spouse" field of the death record in LEERS.

This procedure shall be effective immediately.
